OJC is primarily funded by the Drug Free Communities (DFC) grant and the Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act (CARA) grant.

Our Mission: Growing a community committed to reduce youth and young adult substance use while creating a thriving culture of wellness.

Key Accomplishments

- 1. Helped establish a permanent medication drop box at Johns Creek City Hall
- 2. Advocated for the Johns Creek Vape Shop Ordinance that restricts any new vape shops from opening in the city
- 3. Hosted 5 Let's Talk Events and 4 Let's Talk: Parent to Parent webinars to educate the community
- 4. Handed out over 4,000 Deterra medication disposal bags at local events, community centers, and senior residences

Current 6 Month Goals

- 1. Complete a city-wide community assessment by collecting survey data, conducting focus groups, and completing key informant interviews.
- 2. Develop processes, procedures, and materials to equip current OJC members to invite 2-3 new volunteers to participate in the coalition's work
- 3. Participate in at least 4 community events to provide education and awareness on proper medication disposal, locking, and monitoring
